How it works






Partnership: A tailored support and training programme helps identify what it is you are trying to improve, how you are trying to do it, and ways in which you might measure this. Our in-school training and ongoing consultation builds staff capacity for research and evaluation.



Impact: The platform generates live impact reports making it easy to understand what is working, where. We'll work with you to discuss findings, informing evidence-based decisions about what is making the biggest difference to pupils, understanding what hasn't, and sharing successes.
