



What is an English Hub?



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The Department for Education has introduced a network of English Hubs to support schools to improve standards in early reading and language development. English Hub schools were chosen through a competitive process against strict criteria, therefore ensuring the most effective schools with a proven track record of excellence were appointed. Hub schools are able to demonstrate and sustain high standards in early language development and phonics and have a clear ethos which supports children and families in developing a love of reading.

Myland English Hub—who are we?

As an English Hub school, we are passionate in our belief that reading for pleasure and high quality texts form the foundation for the effective teaching of language and literacy. Across the school, our pupils are exposed to and immersed in a wide range of texts; books are an integral part of our whole curriculum. Talk and the spoken word are vital to the effective teaching of language and literacy; we strongly advocate talk in the classroom.

We combine these aspects with a strong systematic synthetic phonics approach. Teachers regard the teaching of phonics as a critical aspect of learning to read. It is taught daily in discrete sessions, but viewed as a transferable skill across the curriculum. We believe that phonics provides the platform from which children can become creative, imaginative and fluent readers and writers.
